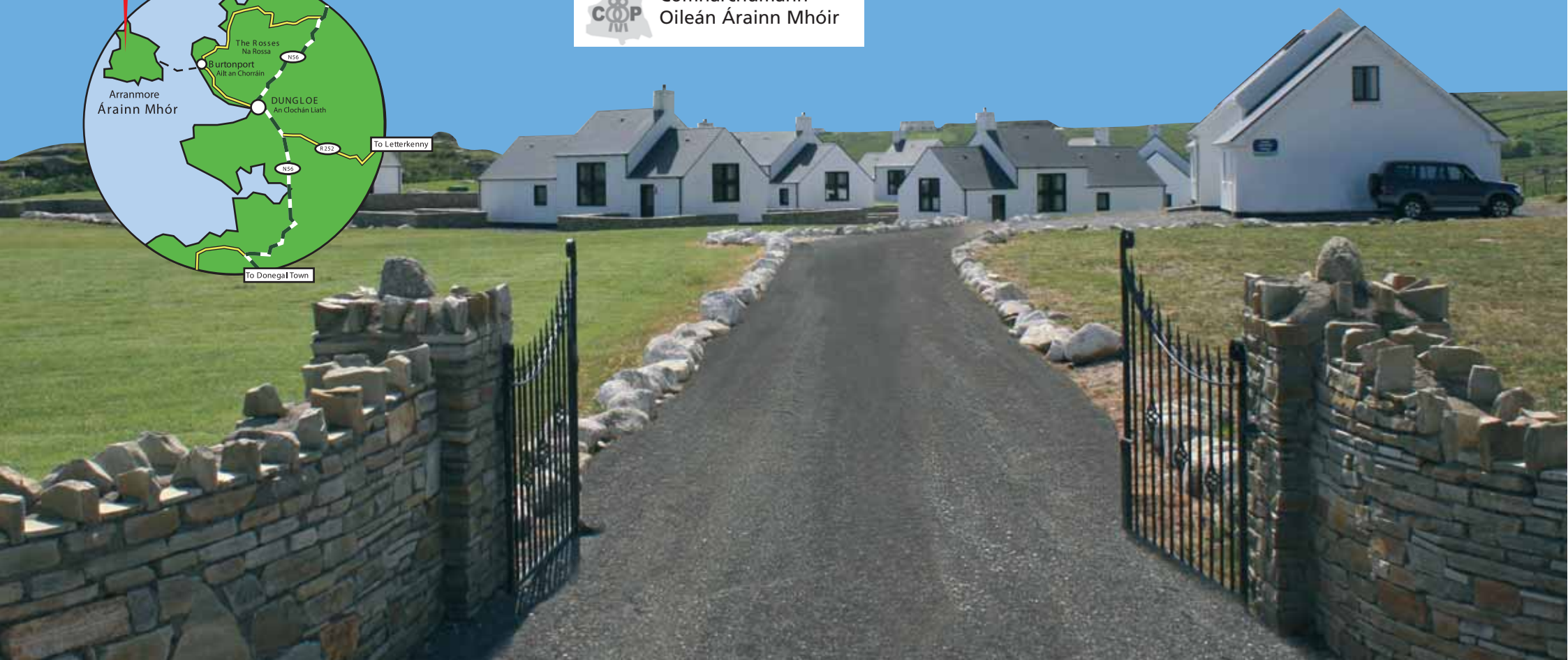

## Oileán Árainn Mhóir, Arranmore Island... Something for Everyone.

Arranmore Island is the largest of a necklace of islands strung along the north-west coast of Ireland. It is a tranquil island that charms all the senses and is located 3 miles from the mainland in the clear blue waters of the Atlantic. It is part of the Irish language region known as the Gaeltacht, where Gaelge is spoken as a community language and its culture and traditions are alive and strong. The island's close proximity to the mainland coupled with regular, reliable passenger and vehicle ferry services from the harbour at Burtonport, ensure that Arranmore Island is accessible in all seasons.

### Stair - History

Referred to in a Medieval Irish document as Ara Uí Dhónaill (O'Donnell's Aran), the island was inhabited prior to the plantation of Ulster. During the middle of the 17th century, the greater part of West Donegal became the property of the Conygham family. In the middle of the 19th century, the island was purchased by John Stoupe Charley under the terms of the Encumbered Estates Act. The Charley family resided in the 'Big House', on the island, now the Glen Hotel until the estate was transferred to the Irish Land Commission at the end of the 19th century.

The recently refurbished Arranmore Holiday Village provides excellent quality, family friendly accommodation and it is conveniently located within a short walking distance of ferry pier and local amenities. The Holiday Village is an ideal base for exploring the island and its surroundings.

### Competition Winner: Irish Architecture Regional Awards 1998 Award Winning Architectural Design

The Arranmore Holiday Village was officially opened in 1997 by Jean Kennedy-Smith. The Village was designed and built as a result of the first ever Irish holiday homes design competition. The design which was submitted by Dublin based architects, O'Dowd, O'Herlihy & Horan Architects was awarded first place in the Irish Architecture Regional Awards 1998.

The competition was organised by The Royal Institute of the Architects of Ireland on behalf of Comharchumann Oileán Árainn Mhóir Teo and was funded by Údarás na Gaeltachta and Donegal County Council.

The Arranmore Holiday Village comprises a complex of eight family friendly holiday cottages.
